

Welcome to Theta Delta Chi's Alumni Newsletter

This electronic newsletter is sent regularly throughout the year, but this might be the first time you've received it in your inbox! The newsletter is sent through our management software, GreekTrack, which also powers our member portal, MyTDX (mytdx.org). On May 14th, an invite was sent to your email address asking you to activate your account.

MyTDX is the official database for the Fraternity and allows members to access and update their own profiles. It also hosts many resources and offers tools for Charges, House Corporations, Advisors, and Alumni Associations.

For most members, MyTDX is useful for setting up communication preferences, updating mailing addresses for the Shield, and connecting to their Charge brothers.



Robert Frost, Dartmouth Class of 1896 was initiated into the Omicron Deuteron Charge on October 21, 1892. March 26, 2024, marked his 150th birthday.
