


It's a Great Day to be a Theta Delt! October 2020

Exceptional Brothers Doing Exceptional Things



Ralph A. Olsen, Beta Deuteron 1923, In addition to being a Brother of Theta Delta Chi, Brother Olsen was involved with the Block and Bridle Club and the Men's Glee Club while an undergraduate at Iowa State. Brother Olsen was active in organizing agricultural cooperatives in Iowa, serving as President of several of them and continued his academic life by traveling abroad to study and promote agriculture, including visits to India and the USSR.

He distinguished himself as an Iowa State alumnus and was a founding member of the Iowa State University Cyclone Club, and served in leadership positions on the Board of Governors of the Iowa State University Foundation, the Iowa State Alumni Association, the Athletic Council, and the Memorial Union Board of Directors. He received numerous awards and citations from Iowa State University. In 1974, Olsen donated \$250,000 (\$1.4 million in today's dollars) to the Iowa State Foundation for completion of the football stadium and in 1976, the University named the Ralph A. Olsen Athletics Administrative Building in his honor.

Brother Olsen lived a life indicative of the values of Theta Delta Chi. He strove to improve himself intellectually, morally and socially in all he did. He exemplified leadership as a value and worked tirelessly to add value to his school and his community. Brother Olsen's life is one to celebrate during Founders' Day.
